The CCGT drive (<u>\\group.clemson.edu\group\Apps\CCGT</u>) is a shared network drive for students, faculty, and staff at Clemson University. It provides access to Clemson's GIS data repository for educational and research purposes.

Accessing the CCGT drive on GIS Lab computers

- 1. Open File Explorer.
- 2. Navigate to This PC and locate group (<u>\\group.clemson.edu</u>, H) drive.
- 3. Within the H: drive, open the Apps folder and locate the CCGT folder.



Connecting to the CCGT drive from your own computer

To connect, you must be on the Clemson University campus network:

- On-campus users, connect to eduroam Wifi.
- Off-campus users, connect via Clemson's Virtual Private Network (VPN).

Once connected to the Clemson University campus network,

- 1. Open File Explorer.
- Navigate to This PC. Click three dots (...) in the top menu and select Map network drive.
- 3. In the Folder field, enter: <u>\\group.clemson.edu\group\Apps\CCGT</u> and click Finish.
- 4. When prompted, enter your Clemson University username (e.g., *gkato*) and



password in the Windows Security dialog box. Click OK.
